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### LAST WILL OF LADY KAYE CARTER

I, Lady Kaye Carter [name of testator], a resident of Yorkshire, England, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and above the age of twenty four (24) years, and not being actuated by any duress, menace, fraud, mistake, or undue influence, do make, publish, and declare this to be my last Will, hereby expressly revoking all Wills and Codicils previously made by my person, and that bequests detailed below be carried out in accordance with my wishes this day, the 1st September 1886.

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#### I. EXECUTOR:

I appoint solicitors Brooke Williams as sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. My Executor shall be authorised to carry out all provisions of this Will and pay my just debts, obligations and funeral expenses. I further provide my Executor shall not be required to post surety bond in this or any other jurisdiction, and direct that no expert appraisal be made of my estate unless required by law.

## II. MARITAL STATUS:

I declare that I was married to the late Randolph Abraham Carter of Denby, Yorkshire and have not been married before or since.

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## III. SIMULTANEOUS DEATH OF BENEFICIARY:

If any beneficiary of this Will, including any beneficiary of any trust established by this Will, shall die within 60 days of my death or prior to the distribution of my estate, I hereby declare that I shall be deemed to have survived such person. Articles in the dividend of my estate should therefore fall to surviving beneficiaries equally.

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## IV. BEQUESTS:

My long standing butler Mr. Percy Jeeves, is hereby granted a trust fund into which one thousand (1000) pounds is to be placed for the care and education of my granddaughter, Ortensia Edwards.

The remainder of my estates and monies, including the ownership of the Farnsworth manor I do hereby grant to the most ardent and loyal love of my life, Cain Dolour to do with as he so wishes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Lady Kaye Carter [name of testator], hereby set my hand to this last Will, on each page of which I have placed my initials, on this the 1st day of September 1886.
